EGGS:

We ship our eggs Mondays (sometimes Tuesdays) via Purolator, Fed Ex and Canada Post -Xpress post. We aim for excellent fertility and will not ship if we are below 90% at home. Usually we are in the mid to high 90's, if not 100%. Some breeds are more of a challenge than others. Not all breeds cooperate with laying at the same time of year which can be an issue if you order multiple breeds. Heat packs and cold packs are available at a \$6 charge. Egg prices do not include packaging. Packaging is \$10/ dozen each and \$15.00 for a 2 dozen plus pack. Foam shippers start at \$10 per foam subject to current market price but we prefer not to use them. Ice chests \$20 are also available which hold 2 dozen. We will do our best to deliver around your requested time but our hens will ultimately decide what happens! We do hatch chicks weekly in order to check fertility and hatchability and I am also filling chick orders along with shipping eggs. I also will from time to time auction a dozen of eggs for advertising purposes. PLEASE understand if I do not have your ENTIRE order ready to go, I still have to move the chicks and eggs out of my basement. Delays sometimes occur. I hatch weekly until all of my orders are filled, usually until the end of September /October.

CHICKS:

We have a very busy farm with lots of animals and busy kids so taking 3 hours out of our day to fly out chicks from the Airport is difficult for us to manage since most customers pick up chicks. I sometimes ship with Ace Couriers, but I also have clients from BC, Northern Alberta and Saskatchewan that come each year so I often can send chicks with them. Or I can custom hatch a batch for you when you are out in Central Alberta. My day old chicks are all hatched and brooded in a special hatching room in my house. I have brooder boxes, heat-plates, feed and water dishes that are all sterile and clean and never are exposed to the outdoors. Chicks usually hatch mid-week and we like to give them a good start so they are ready to go home by the weekend. We will do our best to work around your schedule.

Vaccines: Only large commercial hatcheries in Alberta are allowed to purchase vaccines so we do not have access to them. (ILT vaccine is available in Alberta to small producers)

Feed for chicks: I use non*medicated, but if you have coccidiosis on your premises then use medicated feed if you wish.

GROWOUTS:

From time to time we have extra pullets and cockerels for sale. In the fall is the best time to contact us about those. I don't have a lot of room to grow out purebred birds for customers as this takes a lot of space and as you can see I have a lot of breeding pens to take care of! Contact me for Exhibition and Breeding Pairs and Trios.

I am working on a few project pens and they take up to 3-4 years to complete so check back with me in 2026/2027 for some exciting releases.
